Ask the Realtor: I need a Mortgage

Congratulations. You've found the home of your dreams and your offer has been accepted. Now you need a mortgage. While you most likely have a pre-approval, you should shop around for a home mortgage. They are not all the same. Here are some recommended questions to ask.

What are the most popular mortgages you offer? Which type will work best for me?
 Are your rates, terms, fees, and closing costs negotiable? What are the costs?
 Will I have to buy private mortgage insurance (PMI)? If so, how much will it cost, and how long will it be required? (NOTE: PMI is usually required if your down payment is less than 20 percent.)

4. Will your bank service the loan or someone else?

5. What escrow requirements do you have?
6. How long is the lock-in period for the quoted interest rate? Will I be able to obtain a lower interest rate if it drops during this period?
7. How long will the loan approval process take?
8. Are there any charges or penalties for prepaying?
