Zucchini Pineapple Bread

- 1 cup packed brown sugar
- ½ cup softened butter
- 1 cup shredded zucchini
- 1 can (8oz) crushed pineapple, drained
- 2 eggs
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- ¼ tsp salt
- ¼ tsp ground allspice

Heat oven to 350°F. Grease & flour bottom only of 9x5-inch loaf pan. In large bowl, beat brown sugar and butter on medium until light and fluffy. With spoon, stir in zucchini, pineapple and eggs. Stir in flour, baking soda, cinnamon, salt and allspice until blended. Spread evenly in pan. Bake 60 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 10 minutes; remove from pan to cooling rack. Cool 30 minutes
