When is the best time to buy?

You will need to have a down payment. Most conventional loans will require a minimum of 5% down, 3.5% for FHA. If you put less than 20% down, you will have to pay Private Mortgage Insurance. This protects the lender the mortgaged amount if you suffer hardship and the property sells for less than is owed.

If someone in your family is gifting you money towards the purchase, the lender wants proof of where the money came from.

Any unexpected or large deposit into your accounts will be questioned by the bank. The bank will go back 2 months when they check your accounts.

You will have your credit checked. This is not the same credit score you get on your own. Lenders use installment debt. So consistently pay your bills on time.

Lenders like to see at least a two year employment history in the same field.

How much house you can afford? Get the Lender to give you a Pre-Approval so you can see what you're comfortable spending, before you fall in love with something you can't afford.

Do you know what area/city/town you want to live in? Is the school system important? Do you want a house or a condo? All things to consider.
