Ask the Realtor – I'm thinking about buying a vacation home

What a wonderful idea. Buying a second home is a great investment but don't get caught in the euphoria of your vacation and impulse buy. When looking to buy your vacation home ask yourself - Will I be using the home year round or seasonally? Will I want to rent it? If renting, will I need a property manager? Where do I want to vacation?

Once you figure this out, you will need to determine your budget (do you have enough saved for the down payment), get a preapproval, and find a Realtor. Realtors in Massachusetts are primarily licensed in Mass. If you are looking out of state, contact a local Realtor and they can give you a referral for the area you are looking in.

If you are financing your vacation home, remember the interest rate may be slightly higher than if you are financing a primary residence, as you will not be living there all the time. This also applies to homeowners insurance. You may also need flood insurance depending on where the home is located.

And don't forget to consult a tax expert. You may be able to get a tax deduction on your mortgage and property taxes for a second home. If you rent for more than 15 days, you will need to report the income but you can deduct expenses.
