Ask the Realtor:

How do I find a good contractor?

Obtain referrals

Your best source for recommendations is family members, friends and coworkers. You could join a website, like Angie's list, but there is a monthly fee for this.

Interview your contractor

Make a list. You will want to include questions like:

- How long have you been in business?
- Do you carry insurance?
- How many jobs of this type have you done?
- Can I get a list of references?

Who gets eliminated

You will want to weed out any potential trouble before the job starts. Look for the following triggers:

- You must pay everything up front or in cash.
- No insurance
- You are not given a written quote
- There is no physical address for the contractor (business or home address)

Narrow the field

Now that you have your list, narrow it down to 2 or 3 and call their references. Ask questions regarding the quality of work, pricing changes, communication, timeliness and cleanup. Remember, you want a good price, but the lowest price may not always be the best quality.

Finalize the deal

Get an agreement in writing. This should specify the work to be done, timeframe, how changes will be handled and payment structure. Payments are normally in thirds or set milestones . Don't forget to ask for a certificate of insurance for your job.
